## PASTORAL REFLECTIONS — *Pastor Craig*

I recently had the privilege of participating in the ordination of a young lady from Illinois. It was a day of mixed blessings as it provided an opportunity to see members of a former congregation whom I had not seen in over two years and to preach at the special service of a young lady who will make a great pastor in the life of the church. It was fun to share in her journey and see how God had been shaping her for 15 years since her baptism to this special day. It was also time for me to realize there is a new pastor in the community. Time has moved along and likewise so have I.

Many life experiences provide opportunities to reflect and reassess life's journey. I spent the week following this experience as time for continuing education thinking about the satisfaction of where I have come from, the gratitude of where I am and the anticipation of the possibilities of where the journey of life might yet lead over the next 5, 10, 20 years. There is indeed much we can learn if we but take the time to reflect and ponder the world around us. 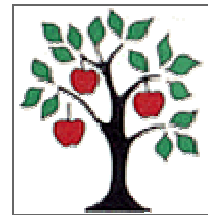
## LAY SCHOOL BEGINS FALL CLASSES
