## PASTORAL REFLECTIONS—*Pastor Craig*



Earlier this month, the Personnel Ministry made a decision to enter into a contract with Pastor Jeff Martinson as Visitation Pastor at Saint Andrew. Pastor Jeff's ministry will be part-time and will begin on March 19. His primary responsibilities will be focused on pastoral care both during and following hospitalization as well as expanding a plan for home and shut-in visits. As an ordained clergy, Pastor Jeff will also be available to assist with worship leadership and may even find ways of making use of his creative writing skills. Pastor Jeff has served congregations in Wisconsin and South Dakota over the past 32 years. He is married to Faith who works in the Merrill Public Library and together they have two adult children; daughter, Hope, in Madison and son, Leif, in Chicago. Pastor Jeff also serves as an on-call chaplain at Aspirus Hospital and leads worship and bible study for residents at Harbor House. *A service of Installation will take place on April 15 during the 10:30 a.m. worship.* Please help welcome Pastor Jeff and Faith as they become more actively involved in the mission and ministry of Saint Andrew.
