PASTORAL REFLECTIONS by Pastor Craig

The word is out (again) and many attended worship just to hear them repeated anew. "Christ is risen! He is risen Indeed!" And then comes the punctuation mark, "Alleluia!" The words are very familiar to us and yet, there is something almost magical to them as they remind us of what we know to be true but that we long to repeat frequently. For six weeks we refrained from declaring this word in worship. Lent is a penitential season and we focus on our bondage to sin and our need for the freedom Christ provides.

Alleluia means "praise God." In response to release from bondage, the first response of God's people has long been an act of worship as a thank-offering to God. Abraham gave thanks that God provided a substitute for the sacrifice in place of his son. Moses and Miriam led the rescued people of the Lord in song and dance as an act of praise to the Lord for the victory from the hands of the Egyptians. The book of Psalms is filled with hymns of praise giving thanks to God for God's faithfulness. At the sound of his voice, Mary Magdalene exclaimed with excitement knowing that Jesus was alive and standing before her. And we, as people of the resurrection, we too can boldly proclaim praise to God for naming and claiming us in baptism and uniting us to the death and resurrection of Jesus. Alleluia! Jesus is risen and we are moved with joy so that we also are excited to proclaim life in the face of death, hope in the face of despair and promise in the face of uncertainty.

Each Sunday is another opportunity to celebrate the Easter promise. It is an exciting story and it is worth retelling and reliving frequently and faithfully. Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!
