Garrison Keillor is a is an American author, storyteller, humorist, and radio personality. He is known as host of the Minnesota Public Radio show A Prairie Home Companion which broadcasts locally on Saturday evenings. During the program he tells of news from what he calls his home town of Lake Wobegon. The "news" resembles old newspaper columns where everyday life occurances were considered news in otherwise ordinary life. So and so were guests in the home of Uncle Ole and Aunt Lena on Sunday evening. The crops are knee high, the fish are biting, so and so has been ill and Pastor Inkfest gave a sermon recently on money which has gotten the whole congregation in an uproar. He begins this news section by saying, "Its been a quiet week in Lake Wobegon" as if little has changed since the previous week's report. Later that same day, the entire group of 65 will perform a concert on the 400 Block in downtown Wausau beginning at 6:30 pm.
