## LOOKING FOR THE KINGDOM

*Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.*  
Luke 12:32

Prior to his retirement, my dad worked for GE Medical as an electrical engineer. Instead of General Electric, my dad had me convinced as a child that GE was an acronym for *Good Enough*. In our household growing up, GE was often the response to the question, *How are you doing?* The answer – *GE, Good Enough!*

As the seasons begin to change from the relaxed pace of summer into the busy fall schedule, it's important to take our pulses and sincerely ask the question, *How are you doing?* Are you planning for a year that is more open and less full? Are you ready for a challenge? What are the joys in this season of your life? What are the struggles and how can you move to care for yourself in the midst of them? To what new thing is God calling you?

The same question could be asked of families. How are we doing as a family? What will our priorities be for this year? Which commitments are important to our family's health and wellbeing? What commitments can we let go of in order to make more room for one another? How can we continue to grow in faith together?

As a congregation, we can ask that question, too. As we take the pulse of our life together, one of the ways we can measure it is by the number of opportunities we had to share together this summer:

- + Many were washed in the waters of baptism
- + A Psalm Liturgy was used during worship on Thursdays
- + Students spent a week nurturing their "faith alive" through Vacation Bible School and confirmation camp at Waypost on Mission Lake
- + Youth and adults spent a week deepening their faith and forming community in the boundary waters
- + The reading reflections group is making their way through the book, *An Altar in the World* by Barbara Brown Taylor
- + Connections through worship and other volunteer opportunities

There are so many reasons to give thanks to God for our life together. When we open our eyes we can see that the life, peace, and joy of the kingdom of God is surrounding us, inviting us to live in that same kingdom reality. Whatever your response might be to the question, "How are you doing?", know that God faithfully walks with you through this and all seasons of life, providing everything needed. So do not be afraid little flock – it is God's great joy to give you the kingdom.
