Advent and Christmas blessings from Pastor Craig, Pastor Jenn and Pastor Jeff

Blessed Advent and Merry Christmas,

Both seasons come together quickly as December unfolds. All of the activities and ministry opportunities, all the planning and preparing are highlighted in the Christmas message, "to you is born this day a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." It is an exciting time of year and it is important that the universal message in Christ Jesus is the focus for what is done, seen and heard among us.

Sunday school children will present "This Noisy Night" on Sunday, December 14 at 9:15 am. This program was written by Pastor Jeff Martinsen several years ago to invite people to consider what it might have been like in the city of David the night Jesus was born. All are invited to the sanctuary to listen in and hear the story as it is treasured in both the telling and the hearing.

On **Sunday, December 21** there will be two opportunities to enjoy the presentation of **"The Winter Rose."** This special music event includes a choir of 100 voices, handbell choir, piano accompaniment and full orchestra under the direction of Al Freiberg. This year, Al is celebrating 50 years of directing choral music in the Wausau community including 20 years of music leadership at Saint Andrew. Please come and celebrate with us and enjoy this special music presentation highlighting the Christmas message taking place at 2 pm and 7 pm.

Christmas Eve Worship on Wednesday, December 24 is a special time for many families, especially the church family at Saint Andrew. The evening begins with a re-telling of the Christmas drama at **4 pm**. Again, with the creative assistance of Pastor Jeff, the skit will be modified slightly to include various band instruments, piano accompaniment and several favorite hymns to expand the musical experience. Worship at **6:00 & 8:00 pm** include the participation of all three choirs. These choirs are eager to share in the telling of the Christmas story through music. The evening comes to a close with a contemplative celebration at **10:00 pm**. Three services include candlelight and **all four** worship services will include Holy Communion this year.

A Christmas morning worship is offered Thursday, December 25 at 10:00 am for those who wish to include this worship opportunity as a family celebration.


