Reflections by Pastor Jenn

I am Lutheran, because my friend invited me to come to church with her when we were in middle school. I remember that their welcome included teaching me about God's love. In their spirit of welcome, caring adults asked me about life and how things were going from day to day. I felt so welcomed, I even had a place in the pew – three-quarters of the way toward the front, on the left side of the church! When I went to church, I experienced welcome.

At Saint Andrew, our bulletin announcements are often accompanied by a repeated phrase, "All are welcome." Those are not simply nice and inviting words—but those words also challenge us to practice a welcome that is met with integrity and sincerity. "All are welcome" invites participation and intentional invitation. All (everyone—regardless of who they are or are not) are (right at this very moment in time) welcome (to Saint Andrew—both the place and this community of people).

If you are here every week—welcome. If you have been away for the summer—welcome back. Or if it has been years since you've walked through the church doors—welcome home. You—and all—are most welcome. And the welcome comes not only from we who are the church, but as an extension of the welcome of Christ from the cross—who welcomes sinners and outcasts and friends with a profound and life changing love.

With the return of fall, we resume a more regular pattern of life and ministry. New this fall is the addition of a third worship service for Sunday morning, a revision to the Sunday school schedule, a staffed nursery, and several Bible Study opportunities—and you are most welcome. This is a great time to pray about where God is welcoming you to connect and serve within the community—from singing in choir to reading in worship or serving as an acolyte or confirmation mentor—there are many opportunities to be reminded of who you are, to be fed and nourished and welcomed—and then sent into life refreshed, equipped and ready to welcome others to come with you to church, to community, and to life in Christ.
