Advent and Christmas Blessings from Pastor Jenn and Pastor Craig

"Let every heart prepare him room and heaven and nature sing!" -Joy to the World, Isaac Watts

December is a month of preparations. Preparing the house for gatherings of family and friends. Preparing special meals. Making cookies. Giving gifts. Making travel arrangements. Sending cards. Decorating homes and yards. In the month of December, we prepare to tell the story once again of God's coming to the world in Jesus—a light in the darkness! Bulletins are prepared. Worship is prepared. The choir is preparing. This work is done so that we might come together to hear again God's "good news of great joy for all people" (Luke 2:10).

In the month of December, in the season of Advent, we are allowed the breathing room to prepare for more than just concerts, gatherings, and the end of another year. In the beloved hymn, *Joy to the World*, every heart is invited to prepare for the coming of a savior, Jesus Christ, the messiah.

This December at Saint Andrew there are many opportunities to gather and "prepare room" for good news of great joy. The readings in weekly worship throughout advent all point us to signs of God's coming—of days and times advancing toward us, of hopes and expectations for a future held in the promises of God. An advent wreath reminds us to slow down and wait —even as the hurried pace of preparations happen around us.

On December 6th fellowship ministry is sponsoring cookie exchanges and gingerbread house decorating (to be shared with a local nursing home.) On December 13th at 1:30 pm the Sunday School children will share the story with us through their annual Christmas program, *"Room at the Inn."* A Christmas treasure sale will take place over the course of both Sundays to sponsor the continuing development of the youth room and the upcoming youth trip. On December 20th the youth of Saint Andrew will do some Christmas caroling and celebrate with a Christmas party.

On December 24th Christmas Eve worship begins at 4pm —with an interactive worship where, with the help of the congregation, the gospel will come to life in skit form—while those who choose to join in "the band" are welcome to bring their instruments and play along with beloved Christmas hymns. Worship at 6 & 8 pm will include choirs that will sing and ring in the Christmas story. The evening comes to a close with a contemplative worship service at 10 pm. Three services include *Silent Night* by candle light and all four worship services will include Holy Communion. On the morning of Christmas Day, December 25th, worship will also be offered at 10 am.

This December, amidst the many preparations, the staff and Pastors at Saint Andrew pray that you and yours might come to know the nearness of God this season—the one who is good news of great joy—Jesus Christ, God's son, our Savior. *Let heaven and nature sing!*


