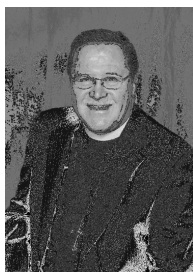

## COUNCIL UPDATE ON THE CALL PROCESS

As outlined in the Pastoral Transition letter you received in September;

"Step two" is entering into transition. The SALC council has been working with the Synod Bishop's office and has now received a recommendation for an interim pastor who can walk with the congregation through the transition period. The interim pastor is contracted to assume a temporary assignment at Saint Andrew. With fresh eyes, the interim pastor can examine the history of the congregation and assist to work through the transition dynamics that follow the departure of a pastor. **Where is God leading us and who is God calling us to be?**



Reverend Gary Brandenburg will begin his interim ministry with Saint Andrew on November 1 with a six month contract through May 1, 2019. Pastor Gary was born and grew up in this area, graduating from Wausau High School in 1967. He and his wife Kathleen, who is also an ordained ELCA pastor, reside in Leesville, SC where she is also still active in radio and coaching ministries. Her mother lives in Mequon and their son & family are in northern Wisconsin. Pastor Gary is a graduate of Central Bible College- Springfield, MO, Lutheran Theological Southern

Seminary- Columbia, SC, and completed continuing education in the field of Interim Ministry at Luther Theological Seminary, St. Paul, MN.

Please join the SALC staff and council in welcoming and praying for Pastor Gary as he shares this important time with the congregation of Saint Andrew.

### Blood Pressure Checks

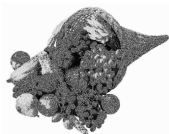
Blood pressure checks will be available **November 18, 9:00-9:30 am** in the library area of the Fellowship Hall.

## SAINT ANDREW TO RETURN TO APPALACHIA SERVICE PROJECT IN 2019

In July 2017, 12 youth and 7 adults from Saint Andrew went to Kentucky and helped bring hope and warmth to people in need through the Appalachia Service Project. ASP is an organized Christian effort, bringing comfort and warmth to those in need in the Appalachian region. More importantly we show God's love through support and friendship with those we are serving. We shared time and hard work and left feeling like we received more than we gave!

Saint Andrew is now planning for a group of 10 youth and 5 adults to return next summer. The trip will be **June 22-28, 2019**. Basic requirements for the trip are that you have completed 9<sup>th</sup> grade (by June), that you have a willing attitude with an open heart. If you would like to learn more, please contact the church office for more information. Expenses for the week will be less than \$250 and scholarship support is available.
