Network Note from Pastor Jenn

Have you ever had a *moving experience*? I moved 15 times between the beginning of my college experience and when I finally settled in to Wausau seven years ago. When you move so much you learn a few tricks of the trade. These were the traditions I frequently came to observe.

Pack light! The more stuff you keep the more stuff you haul...

Establish the "right" fork drawer. If you keep reaching for the forks in a different drawer than where you originally put them, move them to the drawer you reach for.

Always hang pictures earlier than makes sense. Pictures of family and special artwork is what makes home a home.

Have friends over to bless the space. Light a candle and move from room to room to pray for God's work and will to be lived out where you eat, sleep, bathe, rest, and dwell.

If you walk through church these days you might get the sense that a move is underway and you would be correct. Shannon, our church custodian, has moved to what used to be the Christian Education office. The three "middle offices" are all receiving new paint and a refresh with strong support from Property Ministry as well as a new exterior door system being installed.

The physical space changing is fitting because much of the ministry we share is taking on new life as well. In this edition of the network you will find all of the normal fall start-up information you may expect—but you will also see that Pastor Gary's time with us is coming to an end at the end of August.

As he prepares to depart we also are excited to receive a new full time staff person who will begin with us in mid-august. Jenna Diedrich comes to us as SALC's new Faith Formation Coordinator with 12 years of camping administration with the Samoset Council (BSA) and other wonderful gifts in communication and leadership development. Welcome, Jenna!

And after several years of development, the Worship Ministry encouraged council to suspend the Sunday 10:45 am worship service to have better hospitality for visitors, freeing that time for pastoral care and other learning opportunities, and to prepare for the potential of a season with only one pastor in leadership.

Change sometimes can mess with our sense of where we expect the fork drawer to be! I'm still getting used to the new space and desk in the Lead Pastor office. (Sometimes I catch myself walking into my old office space!)

One of the things that God promises is to go with us where we go. When the people were freed from the oppression of Pharaoh in Egypt, God literally went with them in a *pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night (Exodus 13:21).* August is all about soaking in the rest and the best of summer. As you prepare for another *change* in seasons, how might you create *room* in your life to make *space* for God? In what ways is God challenging you to *change, move, learn, or grow?* Let's find out together.

CHURCH COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Church council meetings welcome visitors and are typically held on the fourth Thursday of every month. Following each meeting, minutes are made available in the binder on the Information Desk for members to review. At June and July's council meetings several important conversations were held. Here are some of the highlights and opportunities to be involved.

- Council reviewed and approved a technology and office update plan submitted by a technology update task • force: physical space, phones, doors, computers, firewall, switch and server are in process of being updated.
- The term has ended for Saint Andrew's mortgage. New bids are being reviewed to refinance the current • mortgage of \$723,500.
- Following an extensive joint interview process between personnel and faith formation ministry, Jenna • Diedrich was hired as Full Time Faith Formation Coordinator and will begin on August 19.
- At the recommendation of the worship ministry, the Sunday 10:45 am worship service was discontinued. .
- Council continues to seek a new treasurer and is grateful for Terri Wiederhoeft's faithful service.
- A God's Work—Our Hands Service project is being planned for the first weekend in September.

CHURCH DOORS AND KEYS UPDATE

Last year church council appointed a task force to review emergency procedures. As a result, Saint Andrew is updating the four main entryways with new programmable security measures managed by staff through software. In the near future all entry to the building will be scheduled or changed to a fob/keycard entry. Those who have keys registered for ministry purposes (i.e. Altar Guild) should look for a post card soon that will detail what the changes mean for you. This transition will occur in stages which staff will communicate with you along the way.
