Reflections of Spring by Pastor Craig

The writer of Ecclesiastes says, "for everything there is a season..." Year after year, the pattern repeats itself, spring blossoms return, leading into the long warm days of summer. Fall colors announce the anticipated harvest which then gives way to the fallow months of winter. At least that is how the pattern takes place in this part of the world. I have long valued living in the mid-west where there is a distinct pattern of seasonal changes. I have pondered over the years which season is my favorite but in truth, each one holds special memories and serves a specific function so it is not a consistent choice. While I do enjoy winter—hikes in the woods, the blanket of fresh snow, appreciation for a time of at least symbolic rest—I am also eager for the arrival of spring once again. I am excited for the grass to green up, the trees to blossom and leaf out and the lengthening of the daylight hours. With the month of March, comes the arrival of spring, at least according to the calendar. I recall many a March where blizzard conditions hit hard as a reminder of winter's reluctance to give up easily. Such shifts in seasons reminds me of the patterns of life and which of these I prefer. As a child I could not wait to grow up but the older I get, the more I ponder what it might be like to return to younger years reflective of childhood memories. I would like to think that I am still in the summer season of my life and have much growing and maturing to do and yet I realize that just ahead is the autumn season and next the winter's rest. I am not depressed by this reality but rather am curious for whatever lies ahead for I know that the patterns and seasons of life go on and the changes that accompany them are part of a divine pattern that gives us reason to live with hope. While we may appreciate some seasons of life more than others, the reality is, that the seasons of life do come and yes, they do go. How we embrace the seasons makes all the difference for how we live through them.

As the journey through Lent continues, we also know there is another season that is just ahead. With the cross yet before us, we know an empty tomb is beyond it. This year, Easter is on April 1. What a wonderful April Fools reality that will be. Good Friday—Jesus has died, but Sunday morning—"April Fools," he is risen!


