Reflections by Pastor Gary

Martin Luther loved a good paradox.

The paradox which seemed to captivate him the most was that of the first Christmas morn. The infinite God of the universe became an infant. The incarnation was for Luther like it was for Mary, an occasion to ponder all these things in his heart (Luke 2:19).

Everything about the birth of Christ struck Luther as a paradox of sorts. Mary, though poor and rather socially "insignificant," was chosen. Bethlehem, "The City of David," belonged to Christ, but there was no room for him to be found anywhere in it. The announcement of Christ's birth came not to the noble and elite, as we might expect, but to the shepherds. Luther explores all of these paradoxes in his sermon on Christmas Day, 1530. "Is it not strange," he asks, "that the birth of Christ occurs in cold winter, in a strange land, and in such a poor and despicable manner?" And he adds, "How could God have shown his goodness in a more sublime manner than by humbling himself to partake of flesh and blood?" This is the paradox that rather gloriously confounds us all: God became human.

The announcement from the angels that night was one which was a long time coming. The first peals of it were heard in a garden, the Garden of Eden. A seed, promised, would come to reconcile a fallen and sinful humanity to a holy and righteous God. And then the promise echoes through the Scriptures. Abraham and Sarah heard it. Naomi heard it. David, Naomi's great-great grandson by marriage, heard it. And the shepherds were the first to hear of the fulfillment: A child has been born in David's city, who is our redeemer.

Salvation comes in and by and through an infant Son. This is more than a paradox, this is a miracle. May the miracle bring peace and goodwill to your family and our community as we gather to worship and celebrate all God has given through the infant Son.

The life and ministry of Saint Andrew Lutheran Church shall be open to all who wish to express their faith in God through Jesus Christ by worship, learning, witness and service.



At the conclusion of a significant time studying faith formation trends and following the creation of a report from the Faith Formation Task Force, the council approved at its last meeting a merger of Christian Education and Youth ministries beginning January 2019 to form Faith Formation Ministry. Look for the findings of the report to be featured at the annual meeting and the recommendations of the task force to appear over the next several issues of the Network. The first recommendation (of ten) is to "develop Faith Formation Ministry and associated staff leadership that supports all members on their life-long faith formation journeys." Already underway, the ministry hopes to provide opportunities for all members to grow in faith at every stage of life.

In July 2017, 12 youth and 7 adults from Saint Andrew went to Kentucky and helped bring hope and warmth to people in need through the Appalachia Service Project. ASP is an organized Christian effort, bringing comfort and warmth to those in need in the Appalachian region. More importantly we show God's love through support and friendship with those we are serving. We shared time and hard work and left feeling like we received more than we gave!

Saint Andrew is now planning for a group of 10 youth and 5 adults to return next summer. The trip will be *June 22-28, 2019*. Basic requirements for the trip are that you have completed 9th grade (by June), that you have a willing attitude with an open heart. If you would like to learn more, please contact the church office for more information. Expenses for the week will be approximately \$250 or less with fundraising participation. Scholarship support is available. In addition to youth, adult leaders are required and needed for the teams. *An informational meeting will be held on Sunday, January 6 at 10:45 am.*
