Altar Guild Ministry:

- **Altar Guild Co-Work as a Co-Chairperson** to create the schedule and support team members.
- **Altar Guild:** Set up communion & prepare the altar/chancel area for Sunday worship services. 4-6 times per year.
- **Seasonal Decorating:** Decorating & "un-decorating" for various seasons & holidays.
- **Bake Communion Bread:** Bake extra regular communion bread as needed: 2-4 times per year.

Finance/Stewardship

- 600 Serve on Finance/Stewardship Ministry: Monitor and communicate the financial status of the church and make recommendations to the church council that support continued growth. Assist the council in the budget planning process for the fiscal year. Coordinate a financial statement audit for SALC. Organize stewardship education activities and provide information to help members better understand stewardship and how they are and can be involved.
- **Counter:** Work with a team to count offerings which takes place on Monday mornings at 8:30 or 9:00 am. Must be good with numbers and details. Each team counts one Monday per month.
- **Audit Committee:** Perform assessments of church financial statements and internal controls as specified by the Finance/ Stewardship Ministry. Meets as needed.
- **Endowment Fund Committee**: Evaluate grant application requests, educate and encourage gifts to the endowment fund and make recommendations regarding the use of the fund. Meets quarterly.

Outreach

- **Serve on Outreach Ministry:** Welcome and support Saint Andrew members.
- 701 Assist with Registration for New Member Orientation:
 Offered 3 times per year.
- **Donate Food** as needed for funerals, meetings, events and families as needed. Will be called approx. 4-6 times per year.
 - Worship Service Greeter Welcome people to worship:
- **Greeter 8:00 am Service:** Approx. 6-8 times per year.

Social

Serve on Social Ministry: Develop, plan and participate in projects to serve SALC and the greater Wausau community.

Wednesday Lenten Soup and Sandwich meals:

- 1101 **Daytime Crew:** Help prepare soups from early morning to late afternoon. Make soup, set tables, serve food and wash dishes. Volunteers can determine the length of time they are able to stay.
- 1102 **Evening Crew:** Arrive late afternoon, manage volunteers, give direction where needed, make sure all tasks are completed, help in any capacity needed.
- 1103 **Provide Desserts:** For Lenten meals and other ministry events; 3-5 times per year.
- 1104 **Community Dinner:** Help serve dinner 4 Sundays per year at First Presbyterian Church in Wausau.
- 1105 **Wausau Warming Center-Intake Team:** Serve on the SALC intake team Fridays 6:15 –9:00 pm, November 1-April 30. Must be 18 years old. Volunteers can determine the amount of their participation.

- 1106 Warming Center of Wausau-Deliver Blankets: Deliver blankets to and from the Wausau Warming Center and North Central Health Care Center for cleaning. Daytime delivery-two times per week-November 1-April 30.
- 1107 Wausau Warming Center-Summer/Fall Volunteer: Work at the Warming Center June-October to supervise homeless who are there to shower and have their clothes laundered. Serve snacks as needed.
- 1108 **Annual Blood Drive:** Assist donors with check-in and with snacks and beverages following their blood donation.

Annual Lutheran World Relief Appeal:

- 1109 **Quilting:** Cut, piece, sew and tie quilts. Cut fabric for quilt and backpack kits to be taken home and sewn. Meets on the 3rd Tuesday of each month.
- Loading Semi-truck Trailer: Load boxes of quilts and school bags Lutheran World Relief (LWR). First Saturday in October.
