A Note from Pastor Leslie

50 days of Easter JOY!

#### Alleluia, Christ is Risen! Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia!!!

This refrain punctuates our worship from the first notes of Easter morning until the Sunday of Pentecost, filling the season of Easter with a constant reminder that the resurrection of Jesus is what centers us as a community. The bunnies have hopped, the chocolates are dwindling, but our joy in the hope of the resurrection cannot be put away with the easter baskets!

So how do we live into this season of joy? We are really good at Lent. We choose the disciplines that will stretch us, we give generously, and we focus on worship and prayer for the 50 or so days leading up to Easter. What if we took the opportunity of another 50 days, or maybe even just this month of May, to ask ourselves, "How can I carry forward the resurrection joy with intention and faithful witness to the risen Christ?" That might seem a bit intimidating, but it doesn't need to be. For myself, I've decided to play my piano a bit more and use that time to meditate on the gift that is music. I'd also like to bake a little more and share the gifts of my kitchen with neighbors I've not yet met. Little things that give joy with a gentle focus on where Christ is present in the practice is all it takes.

How might you take this month to live into the joy? It doesn't need to be complicated, just you plus something that gives you life and the presence of Jesus to make it a practice. I'd love to hear about it!

I also want to take a moment to thank everyone who made Lent and Holy week a particularly meaningful time here at Saint Andrew. From the chopping of vegetables on Sunday to the cooking of soups on Wednesdays, our space was filled with the joy of cooking and sharing warmth and deliciousness both at church and in our homes. The Liturgical Arts Ministry and Altar Guild made our spaces beautiful and invited us to experience the reality of Christ's death and resurrection with color, texture, and symbolism. The staff put in many hours on bulletins, set up, tear down, and behind the scenes work for which we are incredibly grateful. Ushers, snow shovelers, greeters, and tech team folks all made sure worship was accessible and welcoming to everyone. And special thanks to Pastor Justin, who jumped into the services of Holy Week to tirelessly lead us in worship. This is what makes us a community, and I know it gives me great joy to be part of the day-to-day life we share. God bless and keep you, dear ones of Saint Andrew.
