A Note of Care

As I write these words, the world outside is rumbling with reactions to the Supreme Court's overturning of Roe v. Wade, halting almost 50 years of federal abortion access. This is a tender issue and one we in the church have struggled with for centuries. Over the next weeks, we will create opportunities to talk about our theology and the ELCA social statement on abortion, offering some space for holy conversation on what this means for us as followers of Jesus.

But in these early days, I would simply ask us to be gentle with one another. Honor the image of God in each other as arguments and differences are bound to arise. Listen to one another in empathy, knowing that the end of a pregnancy for any reason is never an easy decision, and more than just the life of the unborn hangs in the balance. Let's resist defaulting to a binary of right and wrong and open our hearts to listen to stories of those who are directly affected by reproductive rights legislation.

It's immensely complex, but when the church lives into her call to love our neighbors in all their complexities, that is when the transforming love of Christ changes lives in unimaginable ways. It is not easy, dear ones, but it is our call.

And if these conversations and the Supreme Court ruling are bringing up memories or feelings for you that are difficult, please reach out to one of the pastors or a health professional you trust. You do not have to walk this road alone. In this together,

REFLECTIONS ON A SPIRITUAL TRIP

Shukran Habibi (Arabic for "Thanks, Dear Friends")

Thank you, my friends, for the prayers and support for my trip to the Holy Land this year and allowing me the time to encounter the deep history of a region that has been important to the nations of the world for millennia.

On the journey, I and my travelling companions—seminarians, pastors, professors, and others who had a connection to the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago, my alma mater—experienced the cities and trade routes, the ruins and tells, the stories and the legends that surround the land that Jesus walked.

At each of those places, the scholar in me appreciated reconnecting with the history and the politics of the region before, during, and after Jesus' life, while the storyteller in me relished the sound of the gravel under my feet as we walked the hills of Judea, the immense size of the ancient stones of Jerusalem, and the feeling of standing in the places where Jesus stood.

Some of you were concerned for my safety because the region always seems like a powder keg. While we did make some adjustments for the unrest after the IDF disrupted the funeral procession for murdered Palestinian journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, I was able to hear the stories of Christians whose families have been worshiping the crucified and risen Christ for 2,000 years.

While there is not enough space here to go through the trip in great detail, know that I will be making time to share with you my insights on this incredibly meaningful spiritual.

A\$K FINANCE ANSWERS

Some answers to your SALC finance questions

Thanks to all those who turned in questions for us to answer. We are off to a good start. Here are a few topics you wondered about:

- —How much does Saint Andrew give to the ELCA each year? Saint Andrew tries to give about 5% of our spending plan (exclusive of mortgage spending) as mission support to the East Central Synod of Wisconsin (ECSW). They forward 50% to the churchwide ELCA. In 2019 we gave \$31,800, in 2020 and 2021 we gave \$37,200, and for 2022 we pledged \$37,250.
- —Where did the money come from to pay for the sanctuary carpeting? The sanctuary renewal project was intended to be paid for through the **\$40 for 40** fundraising appeal. Unfortunately, the pandemic shut down that effort and we only ended up with \$68,658 so far. Total costs for the project including lighting, painting, and carpeting totaled \$99,175. The remaining balance came from the Property Budget. We are still requesting and receiving contributions to the \$40 for 40 fund, so those people who did not have a chance to donate before COVID can give now.
- -How much of our offerings are made electronically? It varies slightly from month to month, but giving through TOE amounts to about 42.5% of our offerings and Vanco is about 9%, so about 51% is being done electronically. Thanks for all your questions. We will be answering 2 or 3 of them in each Network. You can also find other questions/answers on the Finance/Stewardship bulletin board. If you have questions about how church finances are used, place them in the black box labeled A\$K **FINANCE** is in the Narthex.
