2023 ALTAR FLOWERS

Honor a loved one or special event with altar flowers in 2023. Bouquets are routinely ordered weekly unless otherwise requested. A letter will be sent to you the week prior to the Sunday you signed up for flowers outlining the process, confirming what will be printed in the bulletin and will include an envelope for payment. Cost is \$30.00. Your flowers may be taken home to be enjoyed following the last worship service on Sunday. Sign up on the Flower Chart posted on the bulletin board in the Narthex.

WAUSAU WARMING CENTER DONATIONS

In this season of blessings, we have an opportunity to be a blessing to others: the homeless and those for whom even thrift shop prices are a struggle. You can find containers to receive donated items in the Narthex. **Donate your time** on a Friday evening at the Warming Center; make a meal once or twice every 6 months. **Donate food and goods** such as granola bars, breakfast bars, fruit or pudding cups, bottled water, etc., hand and toe warmers, and large backpacks.

Donate clothing: *men's dark colored knit boxer briefs (M, L, XL, 2X), *women's underwear (all but size 8), *men's and women's thermal underwear tops and bottoms (all but men's XL pants), *men's jeans (waist size 34 & 36), *winter gloves, *sweatpants, *long sleave t-shirts, *sweatshirts, *hoodies, *men's winter jackets (L, XL, 2X), and *men's winter boots. Clothing items do not need to be new, just in functional and reasonable condition. They will go to a general use closet used by the homeless, those who were just released from jail, and anyone seriously struggling.

ASK FINANCE

Is the church still sending out offertory envelopes?

Yes, the church does send out envelopes unless you ask not to receive them. When new members join Saint Andrew, they are given a starter set of envelopes to use until the next envelope mailing. Envelopes are mailed out quarterly. Those members who give electronically via TOE or Vanco get a smaller set of envelopes for special giving only. If you need envelopes, contact the church office.

How do we donate?

As an alternative to the offertory envelopes, many of our members prefer the convenience of giving electronically via TOE or Vanco. To give via TOE, you need to contact the church office. To give using Vanco, select the "Giving" tab on the Saint Andrew website and then the "Online Giving" option. There are also ways to give via a text or from your mobile phone described at the "Giving" tab. TOE only pulls money from checking or savings accounts. Vanco can also use credit cards and debit cards for payment but Saint Andrew is charged a 3.5% transaction fee.
