Go With God - by Pr. Justin

One of the first things I shared in the Network was a piece about the radical Christian practice of hospitality. That ancient lifeline which the ancestors of faith held to and benefited from in their walk with God. You have all extended hospitality to me and my family as we came to the area and began serving at Saint Andrew. Some gave food, others shared their favorite restaurants. As I was packing up my office, I found the cards that were shared with me at my instillation of what we should see and do in the area, and I can say that 80% of your suggestions we got to, the other 20% just haven't happened yet.

The other part of hospitality is the sending forth. This is the blessing and sending of those who are continuing on their journey. Celebrating the time shared and bidding them farewell with blessings for the journey ahead. We may have experienced this over the Christmas/ Advent season as family, friends, and other guests have moved through our homes and lives. There may have been a bittersweet parting at the beloved ones being parted from us for a season. It is also fine to breath easily when those more difficult guests have finally taken their leave from us.

God is part of our partings, as much as they are a part of our gathering. Each time we gather for worship, we gather in the name of the Triune God. When we go forth from the worship service, we go forth in the same name, engaging in mission and ministry shaped by the Gospel, until we gather again. This gathering in and going out mirrors the process of breathing, where we take in oxygen and give off carbon dioxide. Just as the process of photosynthesis within the plants of our world is the inverse process that provides us with the oxygen that we need. This patterns of gathering and sending, of inhaling and exhaling, inspiring and expiring, gathering and sending are natural and beneficial for health and life.

There are even some Hebrew scholars who claim that the proper name of God, which is never pronounced but represented in the Hebrew text by the consonants YHWH, would create a similar sound to lungs filling and emptying with the rhythm of a person's breathing. Mirroring the hospitality and the sending that are integral to our social lives. Reflecting the constant change that, paradoxically, is this life's only constant.

So, we send each other on our own ways. Parting company and siblings in Christ who long for one another but entrusting each other into the hands of the God who has walked with us, is walking with us, and will walk with us all the days of our lives.

I want to extend my thanks to everyone who has reached out over the past month. Whether it was through an extended handshake, a card, or dropping by for a chat, I appreciated your kind gestures in this tough time. Thank you all for your prayers throughout this time. You have truly blessed me in many ways.
