
WE COME TO THE HUNGRY FEAST IN LENT

We come to the hungry feast! This first line of hymn #479 in the hymnal is also the theme under which we will gather this Lent. Hunger is all around and through us, whether you think of the longings of your heart or the physical need that is part of daily life for so many in our community and world. When we think of feasting, we think of the good things that are laid out for the taking, until we are filled and need to return again and again and again. Holy Communion is one of these feasts we celebrate weekly, if not




more! We come to the table with hands open, trusting that with the bread and the wine we are also fed with the grace and presence of Jesus. This grace sustains us for the work we are called to do in the world, being the body of Christ that others might also be fed with the love of God. So this Lent, let's focus on the ways God feeds the world around us, physically and spiritually, through US!

There are many ways we will focus in on hunger throughout the month of March. ELCA World Hunger has given us materials to make learning about global hunger easy for all of us. The ELCA Good Gifts program provides agricultural resources to families and communities, encouraging independence and sustainability through barnyard animals and programs like fish farms and water wells. A pig costs around \$30 for a family. A small brood of chicks is around \$10. Add a rooster for \$15 and suddenly a family can sell extra eggs, add more chicks to their coop and feed hungry children and other community members through shared chickens. A hive of honey bees will help pollinate local crops and give honey that can be sold in local markets. We will focus in

2023 LENT TOKENS

In 1982 Saint Andrew had acquired the land where the church is today. But before the building went up, the land needed to be used by the church to maintain tax-exempt status. A plan was made to grow cucumbers on the property and be sold, with proceeds going to ELCA World Hunger.

For two years, before the completion of the church building, Saint Andrew members planted and tended to hundreds of plants to pick and share with the community. Now, 40 years later, we want to honor that piece of history by offering cucumber seeds (as well as sunflower seeds) as our Lenten token. Take a packet of seeds to take part in our goal of coming together to feed the community. Come this spring, plant them yourself or pass them on to a gardener you know.

What is "Designated Giving"?

Designated Giving is gifts given to Saint Andrew that are given for a specific purpose or cause. Examples of designated giving would be money given for paying down the mortgage (Freed for Mission), for the food pantry, for World Hunger, for the Memorial Fund, for the Music Fund and the Endowment Fund. There are about 40 designated contribution funds available. Designated Giving was \$37,383.94 in 2022. The different funds and amounts given are posted every month on the Finance/ Stewardship bulletin board in the hall outside the church office.
