The synodical expression of the church will meet in Appleton on May 20 to worship together, conduct church business, and learn more about how "To Hear the Word of God and Share in the Lord's Supper". *Laundry: Finish drying, folding and putting away laundry at the Warming Center. Any time between 9:00 am and 4:30 pm, any day Monday through Thursday. Bring a friend and have a cup of coffee if you need to wait for the dryer. Ruth will assist you the first time.

*Warming Center Volunteer: Be a part of the Saint Andrew team on Friday evenings at the Warming Center, 6:00-9:00 pm. The Warming Center will be open in the summer for the first time this year. Cook a meal, serve a meal, distribute scrubs and T shirts for guests to sleep in, collect guest belongings to be locked up overnight, hand out blankets and shower towels. DID YOU KNOW?

If you are over 70 ½ or 72 ½ years old and taking a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your IRA, you could reduce the taxable portion of your RMD by making a Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD) to a qualified charitable organization such as Saint Andrew directly from your IRA. Rather than receiving an itemized deduction for your donation, less of your IRA distribution would be taxable. If you are interested in the QCD, contact the church office for more information. Because there are certain restrictions and requirements for QCD, you will need to consult with your financial advisor or institution to set this up.
