## Bible Studies

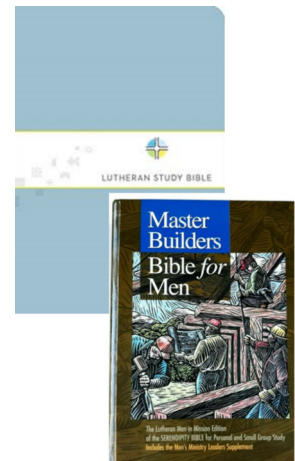
**Wonder? Women Bible Study**

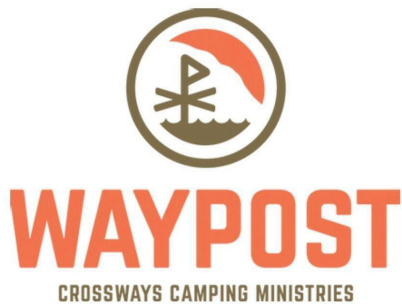
