Stream Team is the backbone of Saint Andrew's live and in-person worship services and is looking for additional volunteers for either of two roles:

- Video Switcher: follows a service order and selects what is viewed on the livestream. Switches between different cameras and the ProPresenter slide feed assisting the viewers to see worship and follow along.
- ProPresenter Operator: follows a service order and cues to advance slides at the proper time to assist the congregation in-person and online follow the
