Sunday School Classes Have Begun

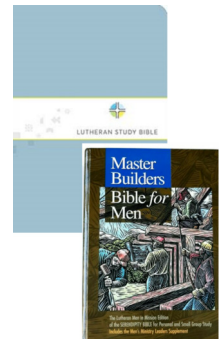
Sundays, 10:15-11:00 am

October Noisy Offering

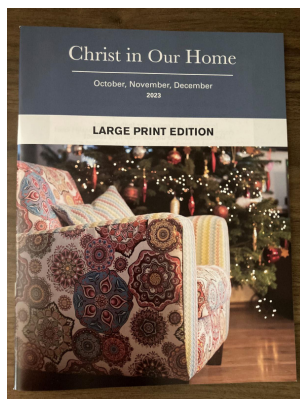
Sunday, October 15
