
The theme and scripture for the day is: "A Spirit Empowered Witness", Acts 6:7-15.

Reflect on Jesus' knowledge of his betrayal to come, his willingness to share of his body and blood for all, and the representation of that gift during The Last Supper. The service will take place in the Sanctuary, with Communion around the table in the Chapel at 12:15 pm, and in the Fellowship Hall at 6:15 pm.

Good Friday: March 29; 12:15 and 6:15 pm

Hear Jesus' passion story as it is told in the Gospel of John and reflect on the stories from his arrest to his burial.

Easter Sunday Sunrise Service: March 31; 6:00 am at the Rib Mountain Amphitheater

Celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior together as the sun rises!

Thursday Worship To Begin


Thursday, April 4, 12:15 pm; Chapel

- *Sunday School classes will not be held on Easter Sunday, March 31


