Wednesday, April 3; 1:00-8:00 pm


Join us for paper folding with all the flower and bee-inspired papers we could find!

Euchre, Sheepshead, Whist, Hearts, or whatever card game that you most enjoy. Bring your own game if you have an idea not included in the above list.






Waypost Camp Work Day Opportunity
