Brunch will begin the time together with a program to follow.



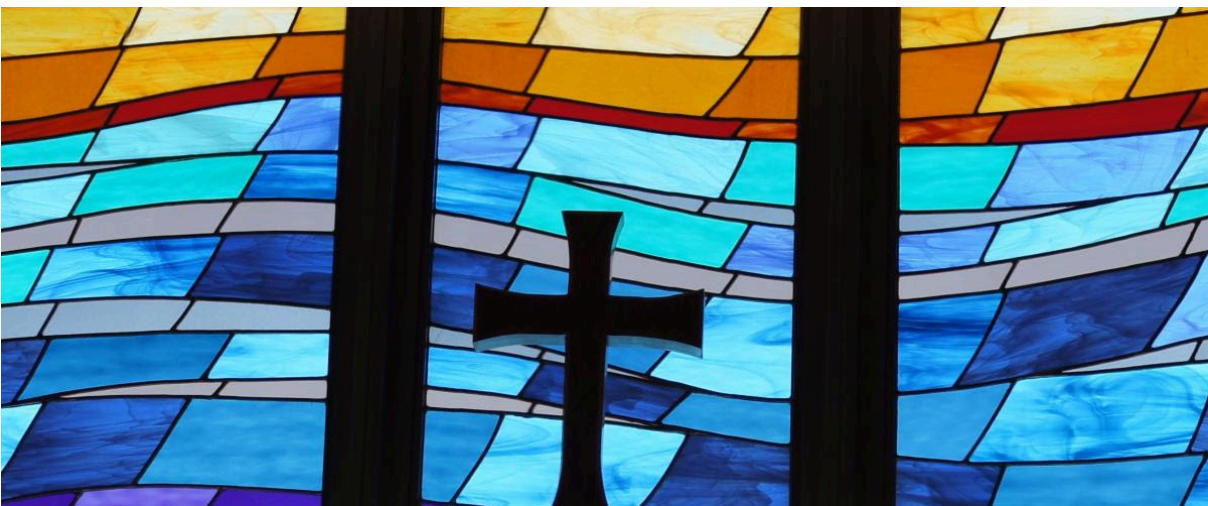

Thursday Worship Begins April 4; 12:15-12:45 pm in the Chapel

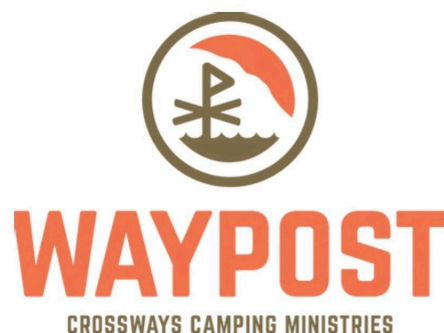
