Celebration of First CommunionSunday, May 12 during worship

First Communion is another step along the lifelong faith formation journey. First Communion class is designed to encourage active participation of both students and parents. With the hope that you will find the class to be both informative and a memorable experience to share as a family.

We have expanded the ages of our first communion class to include any child from age 3 through grade 6. Recognizing that parents come to the table with different expectations around communion for their children, we seek to honor those expectations as well as open our Lord's table to all who seek to receive the gifts of Jesus offered there. Instruction consists of two sessions. Session 1 will be offered on April 28 at 10:15 am and then again at 5:00 pm. Session 2 will be offered on May 5 at 10:15 am and again at 5:00 pm. Families will need to attend both sessions but can choose whether the morning or evening time works best.

Each session will be about an hour, and will involve interactive learning, baking and tasting communion elements, and hands-on storytelling. Classes are offered each spring if this year is not the right time for your family.

Celebration of First Communion will take place on **Sunday**, **May 12**, **2024**, **during worship**. Please invite family, friends, and baptismal sponsors to join you in celebrating with your child as they come to the Lord 's Table for the first time or simply to celebrate that they have completed this instruction and continue to take communion.
