It's that time of year again! Kids all over the world are returning to school and Lutheran World Relief could use our help. Supplies are needed to fill school bags that are then sent overseas. Each bag needs:

- 4-70 sheet notebooks
- 1-box of 16 or 24 crayons

- 1- pencil sharpener
- 1-30 centimeter ruler
- 1-pair of blunt scissors
- 5 <u>unsharpened</u> No. 2 pencils with erasers
- 5-black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1-2 1/2 " eraser

- 2-3 bath-size bars of soap
- 1-adult size toothbrush in its original packaging
- 1-sturdy **comb**, remove the packaging
- 1-metal nail clippers, attached file optional, remove the packaging

Personnel Ministry


• Two to three people who genuinely care for our staff and their professional and personal well-being (management and/or HR experience is helpful but not necessary).
