Service and Learning Trip To New Orleans – Summer 2025

Based on the initial feedback, the trip is scheduled for June 14-21, 2025. It is currently open to ages 10 and up, with the possibility of opening it to as young as 8 years old. Families are encouraged to attend together, children under 13 would be required to have a parent/guardian on the trip.

Service opportunities would include a wide variety of projects from helping with food & shelter insecurities to more physically demanding projects such as home repair and painting. Other learning experiences would also be available ranging from cultural impacts to environmental concerns. Currently, costs and other details are still being determined.

Dec. 22: Revelation 20, 21, and 22 Binding Satan; New Jerusalem


