Special Congregational Meeting to Call a Lead Pastor

Sunday, July 27 10:15 am

The Congregation Council has called a special congregational meeting for *Sunday, July 27 at 10:15 am* for the purpose of calling a new pastor and will be the only business conducted at this meeting.

The Call Committee has identified a candidate for Lead Pastor at Saint Andrew and is looking forward to presenting the candidate to the congregation for call. We look forward to meeting the candidate at Sunday's meeting through a video introduction.

When you arrive for worship on Sunday, you will be asked to sign in for the meeting prior to worship if you intend to stay and attend the meeting. Please remain in the

Sanctuary following worship to wait for the meeting to start. This will help assure that attendees are signed in and for the meeting to begin on time.

Per our constitution, authority to call a pastor shall be in this congregation by at least a two-thirds vote of voting members present and voting at a meeting legally called for that purpose. Voting proxy or absentee ballots will not be permitted.

Eligible voters are: participating members who have been confirmed, have made a financial contribution of record and have communed at Saint Andrew this past calendar year.

2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly July 28-August 2

The 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly will be held at the Phoenix Convention Center in Phoenix, Ariz. I was elected as a delegate to the CWA at the 2024 Synod Assembly along with 12 other members from the East Central Synod of Wisconsin. I am honored and blessed to participate in this churchwide event. The CWA convenes every three years.

The ELCA Churchwide Assembly, the primary decision-making body of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, is a process of communal spiritual discernment. When the assembly convenes, its voting members meet with

confidence in God's grace around word and water, wine and bread, to carry on their work on behalf of the entire church. Over the course of the assembly, voting members:

- Hear reports and review the work of churchwide officers, leaders and units.
- Receive and consider proposals from synod assemblies.
- Elect officers, board members and other leaders as specified by the constitution or bylaws. This year it includes electing a new presiding Bishop.
- Establish ELCA churchwide policy.
- Worship together.
- Adopt a budget.
- Conduct other business related to the ELCA churchwide organization.

After I return (and recover from the heat) I will provide a summary of the assembly and a few thoughts about the process and the event. Keep me and the other delegates in your thoughts and prayers as we do God's work through our hands.

Marketing Campaign Update

I am already putting your marketing contributions to work — with the support and blessing of the pastor we are considering for call.

As of this moment, I have received enough funds to commit to 12 weeks of billboards in various locations around the community to begin on August 4.

I have been able to commit to 10 ads in Wausau Pilot and Review in their email addition that is sent to $\sim 30,000$ area households. They will be identical to the billboards. That will begin in mid-August.

Soon I will commit to a mailing to every home in zip codes 54401 and 54403 which will be set for mid- to late- September.

I always tell leaders that we will do as much as people provide funds for us to do.

I would like to send a second mailing but that is expensive. I would like to do something on social media. I would have done more with billboards but the physical sights I wanted were mostly already taken.

In my last conversation with our prospective pastor, I asked if he wanted me to slow things down and wait for him to make decisions. He said no. He asked that everything continue apace as planned.

So, that is how I will proceed. As we put things in motion to prepare for a second Sunday morning worship service, we do so also in preparation for the arrival of a new pastor. It is an exciting time to be part of the Saint Andrew community!

of using a lathe and turning raw wood into something useful and artistic. Great for anyone curious about hands-on craftsmanship! Potluck lunch to follow.


Confirmation 2025-2026

"The Farm" - by Joanne Ramos

Life is a lucrative business, as long as you play by the rules. Nestled in New York's Hudson Valley is a luxury retreat boating every amenity: organic meals, personal fitness trainers, daily massages—and all of it for free. In fact, you're paid big money to stay here—more than

you've ever dreamed of. The catch? For nine months you cannot leave the grounds, your movements are monitored, and you are cut off from your former life while you dedicate yourself to the task of producing the perfect baby. For someone else.

Gripping, provocative, heartbreaking, "The Farm" pushes to the extremes: overthinking on motherhood, money, merit and raises crucial questions about the trade-offs women will make to fortify their futures and the futures of those they love.



"The Vanishing Half" - by Brit Bennett

The Virginia sisters will always be identical. But after growing up together in a small, southern black community and running away at sixteen, it's not just the shape of their daily lives that is different as adults, it's everything, including their racial identities. Many years later, one sister lives with her black daughter in the same town she once

tried to escape. Across the country, the other secretly passes for white, and her white husband knows nothing of her past.

Weaving together multiple strands and generations, The "**Vanishing Half**" is at once a riveting, emotional family story and a brilliant exploration of race, gender, and identity, and the lasting influence of the past as it shapes a person's desires and expectations.


Saint Andrew Spending Plan Monthly Update
